Join us for two separate March for Science events at Lake Tahoe on Saturday, April 22, 2017 at the Tahoe Truckee Earth Day Festival in Olympic Valley, CA.

- 9 – 11 a.m.: Morning March for Science (in route to the Village at Squaw) will assemble at the end of Squaw Valley Road and march down the bike trail. The length of the route is 1.1 miles.
- 11:00 a.m.: Main Event in the Village at Squaw Valley begins. Educational Booths on display all day including climate science activities, scientist photo booth, and a March for Science sign-making station.
- 11:30 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.: Climate Change Short Films – Base Camp Conference Room
- 11:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m.: Serina Dawn Band – Events Plaza Stage
- 12:00 – 12:30 p.m.: Children’s “Guide to Planet Earth” Presentation – First Street Stage
- 12:45 – 3:00 p.m.: Burrito Bingo – Patagonia Store, with ingredients from Tahoe Food Hub and Patagonia Provisions
- 2:00 – 2:15 p.m.: Asha Dancers – Events Plaza Stage
- 2:15 – 3:00 p.m.: Envirolution Trashion Show – Events Plaza Stage
- 3:00 – 3:30 p.m.: Community March for Science will begin at the Events Plaza Stage with a route around the Village at Squaw Valley.
- 3:00 – 6:00 p.m.: Apres with Patagonia Provisions & Raffle Drawing – Patagonia Store
- 3:25 p.m.: SAF/Earthday 50/50 Raffle winner announced – Events Plaza Stage
